

WHAT IS A PURCHASING COOPERATIVE ??

An arrangement in which multiple businesses combine their buying requirements into a single contract.



WHY USE A PURCHASING COOPERATIVE?

- Save time in the bid process
- Save the trouble of researching specifications
- Save money
- Meet requirements that a much harder to meet individually




WHEN IS IT BEST TO USE A PURCHASING COOPERATIVE?

- If you see your purchase could go over the current bid law limit (now \$40,000)
- If you don't have time to go thru the bid process

WHEN IS IT BEST TO NOT USE A PURCHASING COOPERATIVE?

- If it's a public works project that installation is included
- If you see the cooperative has a much higher price than you think you can get from doing an individual bid

TIPS & TAKE AWAYS

- You must register with a cooperative to be eligible to participate
- Document in the purchasing process to include the cooperative Contract # and any additional information to ensure your pricing
- Verify the vendor to issue the Purchase Order
- Stay up to date on current bid laws to ensure that it's needed to use the cooperative
- Act 2021-485 provided an exemption from competitive bid law for city & county systems that participate in national or regional cooperative purchasing agreements for the lease and lease/purchase of goods & services
